Jack Bookbinder, born in Odessa, Ukraine, was a painter, printmaker, teacher and writer. He attended the University of Pennsylvania and the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts in the 1930s and earned an MFA degree from Tyler School of Art in 1946. He exhibited frequently in many area exhibitions. He taught at the Barnes Foundation, the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts, and worked for the Philadelphia School Board as an art administrator. He also produced a number of television interviews with artists in the 1950s.
