Dear Sirs:

The Township of East Brunswick, New Jersey is in need of a foundry to cast a sculpture designed for our municipal complex. It is a ten-foot, hollow cast bronze, one-half inch thick, which will sit on a hollow steel pedestal in a pond. This will be fitted with an electric and water pump system for a fountain in the sculpture. The enclosed pictures are of the scale model. The designer has made the following calculations based on the model as being 1/5th of the size:


base	151 square inch surface area
Section 1	272 square inch surface area
Section 2	113 square inch surface area
section 3	168 square inch surface area
(at 1/2" thick) rings	100

We think the sculpture should be cast in parts and welded together.

We would appreciate knowing if you could execute this work and what further information is needed.
