When I was in Washington yesterday, I had the privilege of talking with Miss Eleanor Mitchell in regard to the assistance they were giving us in connection with the shipment of books to Russia. She is writing other publishers for additional volumes, and as soon as they arrive - subject to confirmation by each of you - they will be packed and shipped to the Artists Union in Moscow and the Artists Union in Leningrad. This is in keeping with the wishes of the U. S. Embassy in Moscow, and the offices of our State Department in Washington. I am awaiting word from other Unions.
