In response to numerous requests from artists, the Staff of the Whitney Museum will hold a Viewing of artists' work at the Museum on Monday, March 28, 1955.

Work must be brought to the Shipping Room of the Museum, through the Delivery Entrance, 24 West 54th Street, on Thursday, March 24, or Friday, March 25 between the hours of 9:30 A.M. and 4:30 P.M. The Shipping Room is closed on Saturday and Sunday. All work must be delivered unboxed, and is accepted by the Museum at the owner's risk. All work must be called for on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday, March 29, 30 and 31.

We hope that you will send at least two but not more than four examples of your work. Each item should be clearly labeled with your name and address, and work may be sent unframed when distance makes shipping costly. Please fill in the enclosed form to be left with your work.

It is understood that work is not submitted for the purpose of purchase or exhibition and that no verbal or written criticisms are given to the artist. The Viewings are held in order that all members of the Museum Staff may have the opportunity of becoming acquainted with the work of artists.
