
Mr. John Rhoden, American sculptor, will lecture and show slides on American Sculpture at a regular meeting of the English Speaking Society of the Osaka American Cultural Center, 6th floor, Sangyo Kaikan Building, Sakurabashi, Kita-ku, at 5:20 - 7:00 P.M., Thursday, March 19, 1959.

Mr. John Rhoden of New York is now visiting Japan on personal business.

Mr. Rhoden is one of America's promising young sculptors. He studied at Columbia University and has received awards such as the Tiffany Award, Rosenwald Fellowship, Fulbright Grant and Prix de Rome Award. He has travelled widely in Europe, Russia and the Middle East, did research work in Italy as a Fulbright scholar, and has had exhibitions at the Metropolitan Museum in New York, in Chicago, Rome, Stockholm and Baltimore.
