More time than I wanted to have slipped  
passed without you hearing from me. The  
truth is that I did write to you but  
I'm afraid there were insufficient postage.  
I was misinformed. I've somewhat lost  
track of my corresp. as to events along  
the line. Do catch up is always difficult.  
We left Poland on December 1. at about  
10:30 and the flight was pleasant.  
We set down in Budapest for 45  
minutes. There I sent you a post card.  
One hour 15 minutes we arrived at  
Belgrade and 20 minutes later we  
took a waiting car for Zagreb.

2. The ride was somewhat boring because it was dark and the road was straight and flat. Upon arrival at the Palace Hotel I had supper and had a good rest.

The next day was a busy one. Here we have been working more directly with the Embassy & Cultural Attache. It has been quite interesting. The people are young and has spirit, not like Oslo. As the usual program we visit a Art show (modern one - we never saw such show in Moscow) Then a School (very good Academic Art training and discipline. Then we visited a wonderful School for more advance professional Artist. Its a dream place. Dear if I ever come into any money I shall build you a wonderful Studio.
