*(Hereinafter referred to as "Foundation")*

1. This grant is approved under the 1951 Annual Program for use during the academic year which begins in 1961.

2. This grant consists of:

a. Transportation: (See Attachment No. 1 "Transportation Instructions to Grantees").

(1) The above-named Foundation will furnish grantee round-trip transportation in accordance with the provisions hereinafter described under Item 3 of reverse.

(2) Round-trip transportation within the United States can not be furnished, as explained under Item 3 of reverse.

e. Other Provisions: The Commission will pay tuition and other incidental expenses, including grantee's maintenance during the four-week period beginning on or about October 1, 1961, at the Università Italiana Per Stranieri, Perugia, Italy.



18. Student grantee receiving assistance from other sources: Any assistance derived from scholarships, fellowships, or from foreign institutions as salary or honoraria or from other than personal sources, received during the period of his grant, will be deducted from the total allowances, with the exception of the benefits under the Servicemen's Readjustment Act of 1944 (P.L. 346, 78th Congress) and the Vocational Rehabilitation Act (P.L. 16, 78th Congress). Failure to report such assistance to the Department in order that the grant may be appropriately amended will constitute basis for its revocation.

In accordance with the provisions of Items Nos. 2 and 3 of this grant, the appropriate Foundation will furnish you with authorized transportation.

In order that the necessary arrangements for your transportation may be completed by the Foundation without delay, you are requested to indicate your acceptance of this grant by signing the copy of the Terms of Award and returning it promptly to the Department of State.

Upon receipt of the signed copy of the Terms of Award, the Department of State will inform the Foundation that you have accepted your grant and that you should be informed by said Foundation relative to your transportation arrangements, including information pertaining to the name of the carrier, date of sailing, reservations, class of accommodations, and the method by which tickets for your transocean travel and inland United States travel (when the latter is included in the grant) will be forwarded or delivered to you in the United States. It is recommended that no action be taken by you to obtain transportation for yourself, or for your dependents, until such time as you have been informed by the Foundation of the transportation arrangements which are being made in your behalf.

However, if for any reason you have already made reservations for your transportation prior to the receipt of this grant, you should immediately inform the appropriate Foundation of such reservations. If for any reason the Foundation does not approve the reservations which you have made, the Foundation will promptly advise you concerning alternative reservations which have been obtained for you.

Payment of Transportation for Grantee's Dependents Prohibited: The Foundation is not authorized under this grant to pay the transportation costs of your dependents. (See Item 11.) However, if you plan to have your dependents accompany you abroad, upon receipt from the Foundation of a firm reservation covering your own transportation, you should communicate directly with the same carrier, advising that you are a Fulbright grantee and that you are in need of reservations for your dependents. You should also furnish the carrier with the full name and age of each dependent accompanying you abroad and instruct the carrier to bill you for the cost of their transportation. It is the sole responsibility of the grantee to pay to the carrier the transportation cost of all accompanying dependents. For outward bound passage of grantee's dependents departing from the United States, such payments must be made in United States dollars. If a grantee elects to change the class of accommodations authorized by the Foundation to less expensive ones, in order to be with or near his dependents, he is free to do so; however, any savings resulting therefrom will not revert to the grantee, nor can such savings be used by the grantee toward defraying the cost of his dependents' transportation.

Reimbursement of Transportation Costs Prohibited: Grantees are not authorized to purchase their own transportation in United States currency with the intention of having such personal expenditure refunded, in foreign currency, after arrival abroad.

In as much as the Foundation is responsible for obtaining your reservations and making the required payments therefor in foreign currency, you should address any questions which you may have concerning transportation directly to the Foundation. However, the Department of State will appreciate receiving copies of such communications for its information, if you can conveniently provide them.
