Dear Mr. Rhoden:

We have now worked out the itinerary for the remainder of your trip. I'm sorry it took so long but some of the posts were a little slow in replying to our communications.

The itinerary would look something like this but you of course will have to make the reservations depending on when you can get them and have each post notified of your exact arrival dates:

Warsaw, Poland - one week- about November 16 - 22; *Nov 21 - DEC 1*

Belgrade, Yugoslavia - ten days - about November 23 - December 2;

Rome, Italy - one week - about December 3 - 10;

Phnom Penh, Cambodia - about two weeks - about December 10 - 25;

Djakarta, Indonesia - about December 25 - January 4;

Manila, the Philippines - about January 4 - 7;

Seoul, Korea - January 7 for approximately two weeks.

Seoul advised that if you could present practical sculpture demonstrations on Center platforms then the Centers would be pleased to have you for two weeks. They further advise that if you lecture only, they could plan a program in Seoul and regional centers for about one week. Since Korea would be the last stop on the itinerary, you might see how the situation stands when you get to Seoul and either plan on one week or two for Korea.

These dates are fairly tentative of course since we have not checked on airline flights, etc. You will note the Christmas period would be in Cambodia. I suggest though that if you had rather spend it in Indonesia that you arrange it that way. You will be given salary beginning in Warsaw and in this connection I should appreciate it if you would sign the attached Power of Attorney forms so that we will know where to mail your checks. The form should be notarized.

Bob Weisse tells me that we expect to forward the photos you requested by air pouch to Moscow today. It has taken over ten days to have the work done here in the Department.
