Since receiving the Agreement I have had conference concerning it with Ms. Dorothy Gordon and Mr. Byron Coleman, both members of the Committee On Works of Fine Art, New York State Harles Office Building; at the conference I stated unequivocally that the Agreement in almost all respects was unfair to the Artist and that I felt a new agreement should be forthcoming from your office; At that conference I advised them to pass the message along to accelerate the presentation of a new Agreement.

I will be much obliged if your office will send an agreement that is negotiable.
