Dear Mr. Rhoden:

Thank you for your letter of June 24th, outlining your erection schedule. We will look forward to seeing your work go up. You will be interested in knowing that Mrs. Kasuba will be installing her work also starting July 12th on the second floor of the A-B Unit.

I have requested that the Contractor, John McShain have mechanical and labor assistance from their crew on the job available to you. You may or may not need full time help. In any event, payment for their time will be your responsibility. Will you need any welding equipment? If so, such arrangements should probably be made ahead of time.

You scheduled delivery of your work on Saturday, July 10th. The project is closed down on Saturdays and Sundays so it will be necessary for you to schedule delivery on Friday before 4:00 P. M., July 9th or Monday July 12th. You probably should be present to receive and direct unloading. Hence you may prefer to make delivery on a Monday or Tuesday, etc.

We are enclosing photo copies of the proper place to indicate delivery locations. Also enclosed is a map of the city area noting motels that are closest to the site if you need such accommodations.

Please be sure to change your delivery date and so advise us.
