
Dear Mr. Rhoden:

With regard to your travel from the United States to Indonesia and return, you and Mrs. Rhoden are entitled to first class air from New York to the west coast and tourist air from the west coast to Djakarta, plus an excess baggage allowance of 10 kilos each on the west coast-Djakarta portion of your tickets.

You may either make your arrangements through a travel agent, requesting that he send a bill in triplicate to this office, or if you prefer, you may contact the airline of your choice and have them request payment from us directly.

As you and Mrs. Rhoden will require visas for Indonesia, we are enclosing three copies of a letter to the Consul General for Indonesia at New York, which should help expedite matters. Two copies should be presented to the Consul General and the third copy kept by you and carried with your passport.
