Enclosed are ten prints of Supplementary Drawing SA-13 showing method of anchoring the sculpture in conformity with specifications on Change Order #1-44 previously issued to you. You will submit to this Department shop drawings showing the exact number of anchoring rods, the size of the rods, the vertical locations with respect to top of existing stainless steel brackets and the horizontal locations with respect to vertical center line between the stainless steel brackets.

The installation of the sculpture shall be done under the direction of Mr. John Rhodon, the sculptor, and a representative of the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works.
