REGULATIONS

1. This certificate is issued subject to termination by the Superintendent of Schools at any time.
2. The holder of this certificate may serve only in the position or subject for which it is granted.
3. The Superintendent of Schools may, in his discretion, assign the holder of this certificate to a position in the veterans and reconversion program. He may terminate the assignment at any time.
4. The recipient of this certificate shall sign it immediately upon receiving it. If and when he is assigned, he shall present it to the clerk in charge of the time book who should compare and verify the signature. Under no circumstances should a person be employed who does not possess and exhibit a certificate and an official assignment issued by the Superintendent of Schools.
5. Any change of address, or any change of name and circumstance therefore (e.g., marriage, court order), should be promptly reported to the Division of Appointment and Record, Board of Education, 110 Livingston Street, Brooklyn 1, N. Y. In case of change of name, the certificate should be returned.
6. As soon as any woman holder of this certificate shall become aware of her pregnancy, she shall forthwith so advise the Superintendent of Schools and shall submit a medical certificate. At the same time she shall surrender this certificate and immediately refrain from serving.
