Dear Mr. Rhoden:

In regards to your request, I can cover you for Liability for the limits:

Bodily Injury 100,000/300,000.
Property Damage 100,000.

on the premises of Lake Clifton Senior High School at 2801
Le Drive, Baltimore, Md. The policy would be written for
1 year. The cost would approximate \$50.

I would suggest that you obtain certificates of insurance from the transporter and rigger who erects the Sculptor and forward copies to our office.

In regards to the property itself, I can cover under a standard fire policy for Fire and Lightning & Extended Cov. for the value of the completed sculptors for \$ 5,000. ea. or a total of \$10,000. on your premises and the premises of the school. The cost would be approximately \$ 125. for the period of time it would take for acceptance, but no longer than 1 year.

I would suggest that you obtain coverage from the trucker for the transportation of the sculptor on an ALL RISK BASIS, to cover the transportation. This will give you coverage for the items while in transportation, for collision, overturn etc.

Kindly advise me, if the certificates will be forthcoming and the date you wish the coverage. Thank you.
