

Moscow Nov. 17 1958

Dear Shmuis,

I arrived in Moscow from Tachkent Saturday night. Sunday morning we had breakfast (Bill and I) with one of the A.P. men. I didn't mention the EBowys business. The best thing is when they contact you just say that it already made some agreements or contract with some other magazine and any information you would give would be a breach of promise. There's no information here on me that can be gotten. I've always felt the same about "Ebowys" policy.

When I arrived here I knew nothing about what plans were made when we leave Moscow. Today officially we suppose to leave but there have been no reservations or plans made because of a two day in Tachkent. This itinerary I received today. It looks like this

I am signing a Power of Attorney Forms to have the checks sent to you from the State Department.

There seems always so many things that I would like to write to you about and tell you but as always my thoughts are always in a jumble of mess. No coherence at all.

The trip for 30 days here have been much fun for me and my only purpose was not to show how intelligent & smart or asking always stupid embarrassing questions as has been done by some of us (None have been asked of me) So I've made it a trip of much pleasure as possible.
